Passenger Rules:

1. No alcohol shall be consumed by any passengers under the age of 21 years old. The driver may also request that alcohol not be consumed in the the vehicle at any time for any reason.
2. No smoking in or around our vehicles. This includes but not limited to e-cigarettes and other forms of smoke less tobacco and other illegal drugs are strictly prohibited.
3. Any and all disorderly passengers will be dropped off at the digression of the driver and no refund will be given.
4. Any damages caused by the passengers or their guests will be charged a minimum of \$100.00 based on the cost to repair damages.
5. Vomit clean up charge is a minimum of \$250.00 final cost will come after the vehicle has been detailed.
6. York transportation is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen property.
7. Cancelation due to severe weather is at the discretion of York transportation Co.
8. The state of Maine requires that seat belts are to be warn at all times. For carseats please see below Car Seat Policy.
9. The Customer agrees that a replacement vehicle may be substituted in the event that the vehicle that was reserved is not available due to accident, mechanical issue ect.

Limitations of Liability:

York Transportation Company will not be responsible for delays caused by weather, road, or traffic conditions, or any other conditions beyond our control. Any expenses arising as a result of delayed departure or arrival times, including missed flights or travel connections, are the responsibility of the passenger.

Pet Policy:

Service animals only. A service animal in Maine is described as: a dog that is trained to do work or tasks to benefit someone with a disability. This includes Intellectual, Mental, psychological, sensory, or physical disabilities.

Car Seat Policy:

Please make sure you bring your own car seat. The State of Maine REQUIRES a rear facing car seat up to 1 year of age and up to 20 lbs. Children ages 1-4 and between 20 lbs-40 lbs MUST ride in a rear or forward facing car seat. Children ages 4-8 may ride in a forward facing car seat or booster car seat, unless they are over 57 inches tall or weigh more than 80 lbs.
